
Quick Guide



1> Configuration

▼ Configure Device Online

Connect Tempod[®] data logger to PC via USB connection, open online configuration portal ou-tempod.tempsen.com in internet browser, then select the device you are going to configure, input configuration parameters, download configuration profile (.cfg) and save it to the logger created Removable Storage Device "TempSenDisk"

Configuration profile created contains Local Time Zone information, so please download new configuration profile when you are in different time zone to avoid time error.

▼ Configure Device via TempSen Express

Connect logger to PC, open TempSen Express software, select configuration profile you need and click "Configure Device".

Please DO NOT remove logger from PC before you are prompted of configuration success.

▼ LCD After Configuration



← Standby Ready for Manual Activiation (Press Start button) after configuration. Logger enters into sleep mode in 10 sec after configuration, please

START press to activate LCD, and logger will enter sleep mode again if there is no further button actions, until logger is started for recording.

← Auto Wait for recording begins at preset time automatically after configuration.

2> Start Recording

Press and hold $\left(\frac{\text{START}}{\text{STOP}}\right)$ button for 3 seconds to activate device and start recording.

Meanwhile Hold (Hold) appears on LCD to remind you to keep current button action.



← Start Delay (12.5 days)

LCD changes to time countdown if device was set to a start delay after successful activation.

• REC appears on downleft corner of LCD indicating recording begins.

3> Stop Recording

Press and hold $\left(\begin{array}{c} \text{START} \\ \text{STOP} \end{array} \right)$ button for **3** seconds to manually stop recording, meanwhile $H_{D}L_{d}$ (Hold) appears on LCD to remind you to keep current button action until $5E_{D}P$ appears on LCD, recording is now stopped successfully.

4> Download Data

▼ Download PDF Report

Connect Tempod® data logger to USB port, logger begins to generate PDF report automatically, and it would take couple of seconds to complete. The PDF report will be available in logger created removable storage device "TempSenDisk". Please copy the PDF report and save it to your computer.

- Please DO NOT remove Tempod from USB port while it's still in process of generating PDF report.


Download Device via TempSen Express







Battery life of Tempod 90S is 30 days at logging interval of 5 minutes or above, it starts countdown since recording begins, please check the table left for the meaning of battery indicators.

Expiry Date

Expiry date is printed on the back of logger, please use the data logger before expiry date.



After logger expired, logger enters power off status and show "oFF" on LCD when user attempts to program or start the expired and unused logger.

9> Warranty
